002 CHAIR MILLER calls the meeting to order at 4:37 p.m. Reviews agenda.

005 CHAIR: notes bills requested for introduction. Highlights bills, requesters, and presents bill summaries.

015 MOTION: SEN. PHILLIPS: Mr. Chair, I move LC Drafts 3206, 3631, and 3578 be INTRODUCED as committee bills.

017 SEN. PHILLIPS: clarifies that the introduction of bills doesn't indicate any particular opinion on the content of the bills.

019 CHAIR: concurs with Sen. Phillips' statement.

020 SEN. GOLD: happy to introduce bills without regard to content.

022 VOTE: Hearing no objection, the motion CARRIES and LC Drafts 3206, 3631, and 3578 will be introduced as committee bills.

023 Closes work session on introduction of committee bills.

026 CHAIR: discusses role of Senate Rules. Notes hesitancy with the introduction of each bill requested; suggests a criterion would be the relative ability of the bill to pass.

038 SEN. GOLD: clarifies process for committee bill introduction.

040 SEN. PHILLIPS: clarifies a member's process for bill introduction.

041 JUDY HALL, Secretary of the Senate, clarifies process.

055 CHAIR: notes intent to review Senate Rules, and to review conduct

issues. Will provide copies of amendments to members previous to the review.

065 CHAIR: aware of the 1993 committee on sexual harassment. Suggested there are other offenses; these issues ought also to be reviewed. A general committee on conduct appropriate to Senate Members will be discussed.

070 SEN. GOLD: would the committee generally deal with conduct? Would it specify a particular type of harassment?

073 CHAIR: would be a general committee, dealing with all types of inappropriate conduct. Noted in the past there were committees on certain types of harassment, which excluded other forms.

075 CHAIR: adjourns meeting at 4:45 p.m.
