MEASURES HEARD: Introduction of Committee Bills

003 CHAIR MILLER: calls the meeting to order at 12:49 p.m. Lists group of LC drafts to be reviewed for possible introduction as committee bills (EXHIBIT A).

016 CHAIR: hearing no objections, the LC drafts listed are approved as committee bills.

023 VAL TORONTO, testifies in favor of LC 2735.

025 TORONTO: expresses concern about sending refuse 50 miles away. Noted lack of difference in the soils between the two communities.

041 TORONTO: notes that he has worked to locate appropriate sites for refuse. He has determined that through the Dept. of Environmental Quality, there is a monopoly on the methods of landfill regulation.

052 TORONTO: refers to DEQ closing of five landfills in the local area, and the shipping of refuse miles away. Has contacted many citizens across the state who are interested in this bill.

068 CHAIR: reviews process by which the L.C. draft will become law.
