Background

There are three basic tuition and fee structures at OUS institutions: the regular academic year, summer session and continuing education programs. Under existing policy each of the three tuition structures is separate with its own unique rate setting process.

Tuition and fees represent the *mandatory* enrollment charges assessed to all students in the summer session program of all institutions. These fees are comprised of the following separately maintained fees: Tuition, Resource, Building, Incidental, and Health Services. The revenue generated by each element is dedicated to a specific purpose, independent of the other components. The proposed fee rates and policies for the 2007 Summer Session are set forth in the accompanying fee schedules. The housing section reflects contract policies and rates for dormitory housing.

<u>Tuition</u>: Tuition supports the direct instruction and administrative costs of each institution's summer session program. To determine the recommended tuition rates, institutions must balance the fiscal requirements of their summer session programs with market considerations, including tuition rates of competing education providers. Institutions are not required to make a residency determination for summer term but may choose to do so.

<u>Building Fee:</u> The building fee is the same for all institutions. Historically, the building fee charge for summer session has been approximately 75% percent of the academic year rate. For summer 2007 the rate will be \$34 per student. ORS 351.170 allows OUS to assess up to \$45 per student per term to finance debt service for construction associated with student centers, health centers, and recreational facilities constructed through the issuance of Article XI-F(1) bonds. A pro rata fee is assessed on part-time students.

<u>Resource Fee:</u> Resource fees have three forms: universal fees, assessed to all students; program fees, assessed to students admitted to particular academic programs; and, one-time fees for first-term students. Students enrolled under the part-time student fee policy are subject to the resource fees appropriate to specific courses taken. New resource fees may be proposed by institutions for approval by the Board. Institutions have the option of assessing resource fees during the summer session at rates comparable to those assessed in the preceding academic year.

<u>Incidental Fee:</u> Incidental fee recommendations are generally made by student committees in accordance with a Board-approved incidental fee policy (OAR 580-010-0090) on each campus. In some instances, the student committee recommendations are supported by general campus student referenda. The funds generated by this fee are to be used for "student union activities, educational, cultural, and student government activities, and athletic activities." The president of each institution reviews the student committee recommendations. Once satisfied with each proposal, presidents submit recommendations to the Chancellor, who, after review, submits proposals to the Board. There are fewer incidental fee supported activities during the summer term, resulting in significantly lower rates than those assessed during the academic year.

<u>Health Services Fee:</u> This fee is used to support each institution's student health services, which are operated similarly to auxiliary services. Generally, rate increases reflect the institutions' efforts to maintain the self-support nature of these services. Optional health insurance policies are also made available by some institutions. During summer sessions, student health services operations function at reduced levels or are not provided at all. The recommended rates reflect these lower levels of activity.

Fee Policy

The State Board of Higher Education at its January 5, 2007 meeting adopted the 2007 Summer Session Fee Book as a permanent rule through Oregon Administrative Rule 580-040-0035. Fee policies outlined herein apply to the 2007 Summer Session. Fees and policies that are not specifically described for the summer but are applicable throughout the fiscal year (July 1 through June 30) are administered under the preceding Academic Year Fee Book.

- 1. The tuition fee may be assessed on the basis of undergraduate and graduate course designation or student classification.
- 2. Course level designations are generally defined as follows:
 - a. Course numbers assigned 499 and below are at undergraduate fee rates.
 - b. Course numbers assigned 500 and higher are at graduate fee rates.
- 3. Semester rates, including the law study resources fee, are adapted for University of Oregon law students to accommodate the summer session instruction program.
- 4. Tuition may be assessed on a per-credit hour basis or aligned to the preceding academic year structure.
- 5. Staff, qualifying family/dependents, and graduate assistant fee privileges may be authorized during the summer session at the option of the institution. If authorized, fees and study privileges shall conform to policies set forth in the preceding *Academic Year Fee Book*. Staff members or qualifying family/dependents who seek to use the staff fee privilege for courses away from their home institution are subject to corresponding fee policies of the instructing institution.
- Cooperating supervisors of OUS Student Educator Professionals will be allowed to
 exercise contract provisions in accordance with policies set forth in the preceding
 Academic Year Fee Book. The program title has changed to the University/School
 Partnership Co-Pay Program.
- 7. The Concurrent Enrollment fee policy was eliminated effective January 1, 2004.
- 8. Resource fees may be assessed during summer session, under the policies set forth in the preceding *Academic Year Fee Book*.
- 9. The building fee is assessed at \$34.00 per student as a mandatory charge to all oncampus students.
- 10. The incidental fee is authorized by the Board on the basis of institutional recommendations and incidental fee guidelines. Summer fee rates cannot exceed the per term amount charged during the previous academic year. Institutions may choose to extend Incidental Fee Services to students not enrolled for Summer Session, under the following conditions:
 - a. A student had been enrolled in the prior academic year term and is expected to enroll in the subsequent academic year term; and
 - b. The student pays the Summer Session Incidental Fee.

- 11. The Health Service Fee is authorized by the Board on the basis of institutional recommendations for the level of service to be provided during the summer. Summer fee rates cannot exceed the per term amount charged during the previous academic year. Institutions may choose to extend Health Services to students not enrolled for Summer Session, under the following conditions:
 - a. A student had been enrolled in the prior academic year term and is expected to enroll in the subsequent academic year term; and
 - b. The student pays the Summer Session Health Fee.
- 12. Off-campus tuition rates may be established by each institution for summer courses taught outside the campus boundaries. Building, incidental, and health service fees are generally excluded from off-campus tuition rates but may be assessed when the course enrollment includes the opportunity for participation in services provided by such fees.

Special on-campus tuition rates may be established by the institution for selected short-term, on-campus instructional activities including workshops, seminars, conferences, and short courses. These activities require payment of the Building Fee. The Incidental and Health Service Fees are assessed only if students may participate in the services provided by such fees.

- 13. A student enrolled in a combination of credit and audit courses will be assessed for the total hours under the tuition and fee schedule appropriate to that individual's course or student level. If enrolled only for audit courses, the student will pay the same fees as assessed for similar hours of credit instruction.
- 14. The summer refund policy for course load reduction or withdrawal may follow the rule adopted in the preceding Academic Year Fee Book or a rule adopted by the institution. The intent of this option is to provide an opportunity for institutions to apply policies better suited to management of summer programs.

2007 Summer Session Board and Room Charges

The board and room charges as detailed in this document will be in effect for the 2007 Summer Session. The State Board of Higher Education reserves the right to modify room and board charges if the cost expectations on which charges are based substantially exceed present estimates.
