No charges are made for the first three days late, but a charge of \$1.00 is assessed on the fourth day, plus 25 cents a day thereafter. Maximum, \$10.00 each item.

Reserve collections 9each item overdue from reserve collections): Hourly loans, 2nd hour or portion thereof, up to \$2.00. Next 8 hours, per hour or portion thereof, up to \$1.00. Maximum fine for hourly loans, per item up to \$10.00.

Daily loans: 1st day or portion thereof, up to \$2.00; 2nd day or portion thereof, up to \$2.00. Maximum fine for daily loans, per item up to \$10.00.

Restricted materials (each item overdue from restricted collections, per day): Varies by location and material type; maximum fine, per item, up to \$10.00.

Borrowers failing to return material within 60 days of the due date are charged the replacement cost of items, plus the amount of fine (maximum fine, \$10.00 per item), plus a service fee of \$6.00. When such items are returned before the replacement has been ordered, the replacement cost may be refunded. When such items are returned after replacement items have been ordered, no refund will be made. A charge at cost, to be determined by the librarian, may be made for repair or replacement of damaged or mutilated library materials.

Any currently enrolled EOU student, faculty or staff may use the Summit system to borrow materials from other libraries that are members of the Orbis-Cascade Alliance. These materials are subject to the lending library's circulation policies. Administrative fees, overdue fines or materials replacement costs incurred by EOU students faculty or staff from non-return or late return of Summit materials will be billed in accordance with Pierce Library and EOU procedures.

Each institution may establish a fee for over-the counter borrowing privileges for individuals and business and industrial firms outside the Oregon State System of Higher Education. The fee is to represent what students contribute through their Instruction Fee for the borrowing privilege. The funds collected normally will be returned to the collecting library to cover the expense of services rendered to the "outside" patron.

After a public hearing, an institution may establish Outside Library User Fees within the following guidelines:

- (1)Over-the-counter borrowing privileges:
- (a)Individuals-not to exceed \$5.00 per month
- (b)Business and Industrial Firms-not to exceed \$50.00 per month.
- (2) Charges for on-line reference service:

Each institution library with access to an on-line reference service may charge academic patrons the following fees for services performed:

(a)Direct system connect and communications charges, printing and handling charges; plus

(b)15% surcharge on direct system connect and communication charges; plus

(c)\$20.00 per hour charge (\$10.00 minimum) for strategy formulation and search time, beginning with the search interview.

The above fee schedule is not intended to cover long-term arrangements for literature reviews that are negotiated on a contractual basis. These contractual agreements will be structured to conform to the contract requirements of the individual OUS institutions. Under such long-term arrangements, the fees charged for service will in no case be less than the cost of the OUS library to provide the service. If costs rise during the period of the contract, the fees will be adjusted accordingly.

Library photocopy fees:

Copies are \$.10 each if cash is used, or \$.07 each if the library copy card is used. Library copy cards (pre-filled with \$5.00) can be purchased at the circulation desk. The copy cards are \$6.00 for the first card, and \$5.00 if you have an empty card to turn in.

Library Fees for Research Assistance:

The Pierce Library Staff endeavors to assist all research queries. However, we reserve the right to charge fees to individuals who are not affiliated with EOU. Fees are based upon the amount of staff time necessary to provide research assistance; currently \$10.00 for the first half hour plus \$8.00 for each additional half hour. Minimum charge is \$10.00.

Library fees for Photograph Reproduction and Use:

If a reproduction of a photograph from the library print or online collections is desired, then arrangements for photofinishing must be made through the library administration. All photofinishing costs plus a handling fee of \$15.00 per request will be the responsibility of the patron.

Use fees, outlined below, apply to the use of a reproduction in print, film, video or digital format, and are assessed in addition to photofinishing costs. The fees cover use only in a single project; no other rights.

Lower fees may be negotiated for the use of large numbers of images.
