These modifications relax angling restrictions prior to chemical treatment on August 16, 2010 to remove any remaining brook and brown trout as part of a comprehensive project to restore native bull trout to lower Sun Creek.

Need for the Temporary Rule(s):

The Department plans to chemically treat Sun Creek to remove brook and brown trout on August 16, 2010. Removal of non native brook and brown trout from the stream is needed to allow the re-colonization of the native bull trout.

Failure to adopt this rule would result in serious prejudice to recreational fishers as it would deny them opportunity to harvest this valuable resource prior to the planned chemical treatment of Sun Creek on August 16, 2010 which will result in the loss of all unharvested fish.

Inclusions and Modifications

(1) **2010 Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations** provide requirements for the Southeast Zone. However, additional regulations may be adopted in this rule division from time to time and to the extent of any inconsistency, they supersede the **2010 Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations**.

(2) Thief Valley Reservoir is open to angling for all game fish species from May 1 through September 30, 2010

with the following restrictions:

(a) The daily limit for trout is 15 fish;

(b) There are no minimum length requirements for trout; and

(c) All other General Statewide and Southeast Zone regulations, as provided in the **2010 Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations**, remain in effect.

(3) The Powder River is open to angling for spring Chinook salmon from Hughes Lane Bridge near Baker City upstream to Mason Dam from May 22 to September 1, 2010:

(a) The daily bag limit is two (2) adipose fin-clipped Chinook; two daily limits in possession.

(b) All other General, Statewide and Southeast Zone Regulations, as provided in the **2010 Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations**, remain in effect.

(4) Sun Creek is open to angling for brook and brown trout from May 22 through August 15 with the following restrictions:

(a) No daily bag limit or size restrictions; and

(b) Use of bait is allowed.
