022 PAM PATTON, Oregon Alliance of Children's Programs: We are working on testimony or feedback to the work groups. -We support combining the bills into one bill. -We have a concern with the intent of the CCT report of forming support services. -In the bill, instead of being a model, it appears to be setting up a structure of how you want the counties to do it. -In defining the structure of the State Commission and the State Office, you might define the basic services and other structure information and not be as explicit about what happens in a family resource center.
