TAPE 2, SIDE A

002 CHAIR JOHNSON: Calls the meeting to order at 8:35 a.m. >States
that the appointment of two ex-officio members to the Labor
Subcommittee was improper. (MINUTES OF JANUARY 13, 1993, EXHIBIT A)

014 RAMONA KENADY, CHIEF CLERK OF THE HOUSE: Explains the intent
of the proposed Commerce Committee rules, which were adopted January
13, 1993. The rules state that the ex-officio member would be
the Chair, who would not be included in a quorum or in attendance, but
would be a voting member. This does not allow for the extension of
this privilege to any other member of the Committee.

024 CHAIR JOHNSON: Removes Rep. VanLeeuwen from an ex-officio status.

037 CHAIR JOHNSON: At the request of the Speaker, we will hold bills
that have fee increases, regulatory increases, or bills duplicated in
the Senate. This reduces the number of bills the Committee will receive.
