P: SPOKE OF BILLS CONSIDERED IN REGARDS TO THE INTRODUCTION BY  
COMMITTEE. WANTS SUB-CHAIRS NOT TO DESIGNATE BILL CARRIERS--70% WILL  
NEED CZRRIERS. WEDNESDAY WILL BE A STATE HOSPIT. VISIT. CONSIDERING  
BILLS IN FULL COMMITTEE DUE TO NATURE OF THE BILL. PUBLIC HEARING ON

PREVIOUSLY HAD THIS RESPONSIBILITY. 25,000 DOLLAR FISCAL IMPACT.

TARNO: INMATES AND OTHERS HAVE LOTS OF ACCESS TO THIS TYPE OF INFO. WE THOUGHT THIS WOULD SAVE MONEY. MASON: INTERESTING RATIONALE--YET THERE WERE ONLY 2 INMATES REQUESTING OUT OF 187 P: MOVED TO FLOOR WITH DO PASS VOTE MASON; MORE COMMENTS EDMUNSON: ANY QUESTIONS MAY GO TO..
