009 MOTION: REPRESENTATIVE DAVE MCTEAGUE moves that HCR 7 be sent to the full committee with a DO PASS recommendation.

012 VOTE: In a ROLL CALL VOTE, all members present vote AYE. Rep. Roberts is EXCUSED.

020 GIROD: Declares HCR7 passed to full committee. -Closes work session on HCR7. -Opens public hearing on HB 3437.

023 CINDY BECKER, EXECUTIVE DEPT.: In opposition to HB 3437.

030 LIZ FRENKEL, SIERRA CLUB: In opposition to HB 3437 and HJR 22. -Explains reasons for opposition.

053 GIROD: What if a rule falls within the scope and intent of the enabling legislation, but still is a bad rule, then how do we get rid of it?

058 FRENKEL: It would have to be because of a bad law. Go back to the legislature and correct it.
