040 REP. PETERSON: Asks where department is in the process of rulemaking for streamside protection and reclassifying streams.

045 BROWN: We have collected scientific information associated with streamside management, asked questions of the Board of Forestry, then

drafted a first draft of administrative rules which were proposed to the board. The board provided additional direction to the staff and we have now put out a second draft. Public comment period is open until next

Friday. Rule adoption target is June.

We are currently working with a consultant to help us determine the

economic impact of the proposed rules.

184 BROWN: Yes. We are trying to meet our responsibilities under the federal and state endangered species acts.

195 CHAIR VanLEEUWEN: Requests copy of staff comparison of traditional harvest volumes, what has happened to them, and what has affected them.
