012      CATHERINE FITCH: Explains HB 2346 which declares water  
storage facilities development a high priority.

019      CHAIR NORRIS: This bill was introduced in the 1991  
legislature and passed the House, but not the Senate. Since that  
time the Water

Resources Commission has passed a policy on water storage facilities.

This bill will establish the legislature's intent on this subject.

033      MOTION: REP. MARKHAM: Moves that HB 2346 be sent to the  
Full Committee with a DO PASS recommendation.

CHAIR NORRIS: Repeats the motion.

VOTE: On a roll call vote, all members present vote AYE. REP.
