SB 1057 - WORK SESSION Witnesses: Brian Gregor, ODOT Brent Curtis, Washington County & County Planning Directors

012 BRIAN GREGOR: Summarizes written testimony (EXHIBIT A) on status of SB 1057, concept of amendment, and work remaining to be done.

037 BRENT CURTIS: Think concept presented is a workable idea.

070 SEN. JOHNSON: Reviews SB 1067 as revised after discussions with Art Schlack (EXHIBIT B). 093 SEN. SHOEMAKER: Is notice provided to neighboring lands about information being provided with the Division?

097 SEN. JOHNSON: We added that the information that would be filed with the Division will also be filed with the county. Did not specifically say that all adjoining land owners need to be notified.

115 ART SCHLACK: Senator Johnson has worked diligently to address the concerns identified by the county planning directors. Has made progress. Will review draft (EXHIBIT B) with planning directors on Friday and

continue to work with Senator Johnson to see if a piece of legislation that can be supported can be developed. 127 ERNIE KEUNZ: Expresses concerns with airstrip in his area which is a parachute jump.
