(EXHIBIT C) submitted by President Bradbury; a measure that
memorializes Congress to conduct an investigation into the recent
decision of the U.S. Commerce Department to overturn a longstanding

policy awarding the majority of the Pacific whiting catch to Oregon coast shore-based processors (EXHIBIT D) submitted by President Bradbury; and a measure to establish the Oregon Government Productivity Act (EXHIBIT E) submitted by the Senate Legislative Committee on Trade and Economic Development.
