Speaker Campbell greeted those attending and outlined the purpose for this committee. The State has been mandating many things onto the Counties, Cities and education which have a fiscal impact on those entities as to how to pay for the programs mandated.

Speaker Campbell suggested that this committee look at mandates which have been placed on Cities and Counties that are no longer appropriate, but still costly; mandates that are not worthwhile; and those that should be eliminated no matter what the costs are.

He asked that the Committee move along rapidly as time is of the essence. He suggested the Committee members return home; and, with their groups, put together as much as they can; return in one week to meet together and compile a list. Then to meet in another week to put together a finalized list. The Committee would be working with Legislators to convert those ideas into legislation.

Speaker Campbell would like to see this committee continue as a formal task force for the purpose of feedback from Cities and Counties and input to the legislative process.

It was decided that each issue should be indentified by statute number or administrative rule that causes the mandate. Also fiscal impact statements as to the cost of these mandates on the individual entities should be included.
