001 CHAIR BAUM: Convenes Conference Committee on HB 2026 at 5:35 p.m.

007 GREG CHAIMOV: HB 2026 in its original form clarified the timelines the claimant had to follow when filing a claim to property being seized under the asset forfeiture law.

When the bill came back to the House it included provisions to streamline the statement that the claimant had to file, including information about why the claimant wanted the property back, and also provided an express provision to allow a claimant to defer a forfeiture case pending the outcome of a feared criminal prosecution.

Understands that neither of the Senate amendments are perceived to be egregious. Rep. Mannix has a suggestion for improving the bill.

020 REP. MANNIX: Reviews page 1, line 18 of HB 2026-B Engrossed.
