CEASE explained why the urban renewal portion of Measure 5 was put into HB 2609. 015 CHAIR JONES discussed past concerns regarding how to communicate to the public regarding the urban renewal portion being outside of Measure 5. 065 REP. PARKINSON explained that local government issues are very complex and were removed from HB 2550 in order to deal with urban renewal issues. Noted his disappointment for the Senate moving urban renewal from HB 2609 to HB 2550. 126 SEN. BRENNEMAN voiced his concerns with provisions requiring an elected official to sit on the urban renewal board. Noted the deletion of the housing authority acting as a board was not a problem to him. 194 Questions and discussion followed regarding public buildings. 240 REP. WHITTY expressed his opinion that local government will be tempted to go around the wishes of the voters if there is no limit on public buildings. 263 SEN. BRENNEMAN explained that what is working in one city does not always work in another. 390 CHAIR JONES conducted adminstrative business and emphasized that Measure 5 has changed things with discussion interspersed.
