004 HOLLY ROBINSON: Summarizes provisions of HB 3495.

019 REP. CLARK: What constitutes probable cause to find out whether someone has alcohol in his system?

021 ROBINSON: Probable cause threshold is the same as it would be under a normal situation. This does not create new grounds on which to stop an individual.

026 LIEUTENANT GLEN RADER, OREGON STATE POLICE: Reviews chart explaining how DUII, suspension, and criminal procedure systems work (EXHIBIT B).
