HOUSE MEMBERS PRESENT: Rep. Parks Rep. Roberts Rep. Taylor

CHAIR DUKES: Calls the meeting to order at 10:13. -Explains the status of the SB 485.

SENATOR KINTIGH: Discusses the reasons for the non-concurrence.

REPRESENTATIVE TAYLOR: I offered the amendments dealing with the funds.

RUTH LARSON, COMMITTEE ADMINISTRATOR: Tells the difference between the vanity plate money and what is in the maintenance limitation account. Priorities are set for the distribution of the fund.

SENATOR KINTIGH: To answer the concern about the impact on jobs, the availability for growth is limited. They are at the peak for employment levels.

REPRESENTATIVE ROBERTS: I have no problem with this amendment.

MOTION: REPRESENTATIVE ROBERTS MOVES THE -2 AMENDMENTS TO SB 485.

VOTE: HEARING NO OBJECTION, CHAIR DUKES SO MOVES.

MOTION: SENATOR KINTIGH MOVES THE CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT TO BOTH

FLOORS WITH A "DO PASS" RECOMMENDATION.

VOTE: IN A ROLL CALL VOTE, THE MOTION CARRIES, WITH ALL MEMBERS VOTING AYE.

CHAIR DUKES: Adjourns the meeting at 10:10.
