meeting to order at 5:10. WORK SESSION - SB 814 006 CHAIR CEASE
referred to House Amendments to SB 814-A, School Finance Formula SB 814B
and School Finance Simulation #30. Exhibits 1, 2, 3 015 TERRY DRAKE
noted School Finance Simulation #30 is a summary simulation and the
numbers are the same as School Finance Simulation #29. 020 CHAIR CEASE
explained the Senate objections with SB 814B as the removal of the
placeholders from SB 814A and including those placeholders for an
interim review. She believed the placeholders which were removed could
contribute to the cost of education. 046 SEN. BRENNEMAN discussed the
work on the school finance formula in the Senate Revenue Committee. He
discussed Colorado's work at arriving at an equalization process using a
regional division of the state. He explained why he preferred the House
version of SB 814. 065 REP. PARKINSON reviewed the work in the House
Revenue Committee. After many discussions the House Republican caucus
accepted the hold harmless provision in the House version. He noted
problems with the House Republican caucus if the placeholders are
inserted in SB 814. 084 SEN. GOLD noted concern with the Legislature's
commitment if the placeholders are removed from SB 814.

114 REP. JONES noted her concern with including placeholders prior to

of related issues. She noted her commitment to the children of Oregon.
160 REP. WHITTY reviewed the House Revenue Committee discussions
regarding placeholders and the issues to be included in an interim
study. He noted the final vote of 9-0 with which the House Revenue
Committee supported SB 814 B. 202 CHAIR CEASE requested consideration
for the placeholders which were in SB 814A (page 3, lines 32, 33, 35 in
SB 814A) with reference to a cost of living factor. She reviewed the
Senate Revenue Committee's discussion relating to the cost of
education/living. She pointed out 'the placeholder language relating to
high mobility students and prekindergarten students (page 4, 25, 26 in
SB 814A). She noted that the placeholders she described are different
than what was presented in the House Revenue Committee. 237 Questions
and discussion clarifying the request of the Senate. 240 CHAIR JONES
explained a specific decision in the House Revenue Committee of not
giving specific interest to certain factors because of the lack of data.
251 SEN. GOLD requested information regarding the proposed Department
of Education interim study. 275 STEVE BENDER referred to Section 6 in
SB 814B and reviewed the proposed requirements by the Department of
Revenue. He pointed out two reports to be presented to the Joint Interim
Revenue Committee. 300 SEN. GOLD questioned the participation from the
Joint Interim Revenue Committee in the proposed study. 308 CHAIR
PARKINSON noted his confidence in coordination between the Department of
Education and the Joint Interim Revenue Committee. 317 Questions and
discussion regarding the Senate version of SB 814. 322 SEN. GOLD
explained the placeholders in the Senate version of SB 814 made it

imperative for a proactive participation during the interim. The removal of the placeholders places the imperative on the Department of Education and the Joint Interim Revenue Committee as the recipient. 333 REP. JONES could not locate the language in SB 814A as described by Sen. Gold. 346 SEN. GOLD explained the intent from the Senate Revenue Committee is clear that the only way a law would come about would be with the Joint Interim Revenue Committee dealing with those issues.
