005 CHAIR CEASE called the meeting to order at 1:17 and conducted administrative business.

WORK SESSION - HB
255 0A

011 JIM SCHERZINGER explained changes have been identified in the working draft of HB 2550A. There are no changes in policy but most of the changes relate to the converting back to an additional tax from a penalty for the partial or full exemptions. EXHIBIT 1

032 JIM SCHERZINGER explained Legislative Counsel has some repeal changes which will be technical editing corrections. EXHIBIT 2

043 JIM KENNEY referred to Page 4, Line 24, EXHIBIT 1, after the word "zone" delete "on or". EXHIBIT 1

050 CONSENSUS CHAIR CEASE noted no objection to the amendment described by Jim Kenney on Line 24, Page 4, EXHIBIT 1

062 SEN. DUKES suggested adopting all the technical amendments recommended by the DOR since there are no policy changes.

069 JIM SCHERZINGER explained that he has been through the amendments with the DOR and the amendments are doing what the committee as already adopted. All of the changes are documented in the DOR's working draft. EXHIBIT 5

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078 JIM SCHERZINGER discussed the recommended changes by Legislative Counsel which are technical dealing with form and style, or spelling. EXHIBIT 2

081 CHAIR CEASE explained the committee would be adopting the DOR's technical amendments together with the Legislative Counsel's form and style amendments in concept.

085 CONSENSUS CHAIR CEASE noted no objection to adopt the DOR's technical amendments (EXHIBIT 5) together with the Legislative Counsel's form and style amendments (EXHIBIT 2) in concept.

088 SEN. BRENNEMAN questioned the application of Subsection 1 as it relates to Subsection 2 in Section 215, Page 207. EXHIBIT 1

094 JIM KENNEY explained the intent is that the single code area in Subsection 1 would also apply for the Subsection 2 properties which are the specially assessed properties.

122 SEN. BRENNEMAN presented a change regarding the word "additional tax" for the word "penalty". It was clarified that the changes have already been incorporated in the amendments by the DOR. EXHIBIT 5

128 SEN. DUKES raised the question of the nonuniform tax issue and wondered if it is statutorily possible to do anything about the issue.

142 JIM KENNEY explained it is probably a limitation by the Constitution.

147 CHAIR CEASE commented that if the nonuniform tax issue turns out not to be a Constitution limitation there will be a cleanup bill to address other property tax issues.

160 SEN. SMITH commented on Page 107, Section 109a, EXHIBIT 1 and

questioned the notification on the tax statement of delinquent taxpayers.
185 JIM KENNY responded there is a section on the tax statement to explain
the repeal rights of the taxpayer.
188 CHAIR CEASE pointed out that HB 2550A has been amended.
191 MOTION SEN. DUKES moved HB 2550A as amended to the floor with
a do pass recommendation.

256 MOTION SEN. BRENNEMAN moved to adopt the proposed amendments as amended
to HB 2609A dated 6/7/91 by LRO. EXHIBIT 6
261 CONSENSUS CHAIR CEASE noted no objection to the motion.
265 MOTION SEN. BRENNEMAN moved amended HB 2609A to the floor of
the Senate with a do pass recommendation.
