 $\tt 058\ HANNON:$  It commends Israel for their restraint in the Iraqi situation. Supporters of the Jewish

community would like to have it before Israel..(tape inaudible).

063 ROBERTS: We can put up a notice today and meet immediately after session tomorrow. I think

we can put it on the agenda on suspension of the rules. We can have it on the Senate calendar on Friday.

We will soon start getting requests in for bills that didn't meet the deadline. I hope you agree

with my standard rule, which is that we don't even consider consider approving a bill for

introduction until the sponsor of the bill has gotten assurance of a hearing from the committee  $\,$ 

to which it would be assigned.
