009 CHAIR ROBERTS: Calls the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m.. Opens public hearing and work session on SCR 1.

MOTION:Sen. Roberts asked if there was objection to sending SCR 1 to the floor, thereby effectively moving SCR 1 to the floor with a "do pass" recommendation.

VOTE:There being no objection, the motion was unanimously approved. Sen. Bradbury and Cohen were excused.

014 ROBERTS: Suggests Sen. Brockman carry the bill since he is the sponsor; will consult with him.  
Closes public hearing and work session on SCR 1. Opens public hearing and work session on HCR1.

This is in memorium of former Representative Wally Priestley. [QUOTE] "I like the unabashed, liberal, populist and spokesman for the disenfranchised, often frustrated, angered, amused, prodded and persuaded friend and foe alike."

027 CEASE: I suppose we want to leave the House's word "forceful" instead of "sane" view of nuclear power. It was "sane" on line 15 and they changed it to "forceful".

032 MOTION: Sen. Roberts asked if there was objection to sending HCR1 to the floor, effectively moving HCR1 to the floor with a "do pass" recommendation.

VOTE: There being no objection, the motion was unanimously approved. Sen. Bradbury and Cohen were excused.

044 ROBERTS: Senators Gold and Phillips have sponsored SCR 3, which came to us too late to be scheduled for today's meeting and they would like to have it done quickly.

048 HANNON: Could we move it up on the agenda for Thursday so we can make the 24 hours notice and take a vote on the floor or right now in support of moving it out?

050 CEASE: I'm not sure I want to vote for it. I don't think there is anybody over there without blame.

053 HANNON: I would rather move it now before they do get involved.

054 CEASE: I may vote against it on the floor.

058 HANNON: It commends Israel for their restraint in the Iraqi situation. Supporters of the Jewish community would like to have it before Israel..(tape inaudible).

063 ROBERTS: We can put up a notice today and meet immediately after session tomorrow. I think we can put it on the agenda on suspension of the rules. We can have it on the Senate calendar on Friday.

We will soon start getting requests in for bills that didn't meet the deadline. I hope you agree with my standard rule, which is that we don't even consider approving a bill for introduction until the sponsor of the bill has gotten assurance of a hearing from the committee to which it would be assigned.

There was general agreement.
