TAPE 8, SIDE A

005 CHAIR ROBERTS: Calls the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m.. Submits and summarizes requests for approval of late drafting and introduction of late measures and sponsorship by committee.
(EXHIBIT A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L, M).

MOTION: SEN. ROBERTS asked if there was objection to approval of introduction of the measure (EXHIBIT A) relating to former Senator Gordon McKay, and to further allow committee sponsorship of the measure.

MOTION: SEN. ROBERTS asked if there was objection to approval of late drafting and introduction of these measures, thereby effectively moving that the Senate Rules Committee authorize Legislative Counsel to draft legislation relating to the exhibited measures, and to further allow introduction of these measures.

042 ROBERTS: I dissuaded Senator McCoy from introducing a bill that related directly to one of the Human Resources budget.

We are getting a lot of late requests and maybe we should tighten down on them.

050 HANNON: I think we should initiate a memorandum to all of our

colleagues indicating that we will be less flexible in approving bill requests.

057 VOTE: There being no objection, both motions were approved. Senator Dukes was excused.

060 ROBERTS: Opens work session on SB 36a The bill was referred to Rules Committee because of a question of fiscal impact on local governments.

064 JOSE MATA, SENATE RULES COMMITTEE ADMINISTRATOR:
The President's office has put for subsequent referrals to this committee several bills that would have a fiscal impact on local government without offsetting revenue. This bill in its original form would have required pre-apprenticeship programs in the schools. In its current form it only encourages the development of pre-apprenticeship programs and therefore doesn't have a fiscal impact.

069 MOTION: SENATOR HANNON moves to send SB 36A to the floor with a "do pass" recommendation.

071 ROBERTS: Asks if there is an objection to asending SB 36A to the floor with a "do pass" recommendation. Clarifies that the amended bill has no fiscal implications.

076 VOTE: There being no objection, the motion was unanimously approved. Senator Dukes was excused.

076 ROBERTS: Closes work session on SB 36A. Opens work session on HCR5.

080 MOTION: SENATOR BRENNEMAN moves to send HCR5 to the floor with a "do pass" recommendation.

082 ROBERTS: Asks if there is an objection to sending HCR5 to the floor with a "do pass" recommendation.

084 VOTE: There being no objection, the motion was unanimously approved. Senator Dukes was excused. Adjourns the meeting at 12:25 p.m..
