006 VICE-CHAIR BRADBURY: Calls the meeting to order at 12:10 p.m.

Submits and summarizes requests for approval of late drafting and introduction of late measures.

014 MOTION: SEN. BRADBURY asked if there was objection to approval of late drafting and

introduction of the measure (EXHIBIT A) relating to non-government builders of roads providing footpaths and bicycle trail, and further allow introduction of the measures.

VOTE: There being no objection, the motion was unanimously approved.

021 MOTION: SEN. BRADBURY asked if there was objection to approval of late drafting and introduction of the measure (EXHIBIT B) relating to transit districts drawing their own subdivision boundaries based on population census data, and further allow introduction of the measure.

VOTE: There being no objection, the motion was unanimously approved.

022 DUKES: This session, we have the Columbia River Resource Task Force on which we're working to determine what, if anything, will be listed as threatened on the river, what we must do, what the impacts will be and how we can mitigate them.

We need authorization to have something drafted that probably won't be produced this session. It would be a four state piece of legislation and we are the only state that is still in session. The Committee needs the opportunity to be able to begin working language on it and send it out to the other states.

031 ROBERTS: Suggests asking the Rules Committee, now assembled, to permit you to have a bill drafted and then bring it back to the Committee for possible introduction.

034 MOTION: SEN. ROBERTS asked if there was objection to approval of late drafting of a measure relating to the Columbia River Resource Task Force.

VOTE: There being no objection, the motion was unanimously approved.

Mr. Faatz has done a good job at guiding the State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision through a time when they were losing powers and decreasing their numbers according to work load. He found innovative ways to keep the numbers and keep things in tact. In favor of the reappointment.
