to be a member of the health care profession and would serve in the place of the regular member in that person's absence.

for 3 years and there are times due to another engagement that a member can't attend. Having only  $5\,$ 

members there have been times when a quorum hasn't been present and we can't conduct business. This

bill would be an opening to have another member on the committee that can be called upon when we

needed another member. This bill would have no fiscal impact.
