PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SECTION 3

RIGHT OF WAY
Preliminary Draft No. 1

Section 3. (Stop signs and yield signs.)

(4) An official traffic control device placed pursuant to subsection (1) of this section shall conform to specifications approved by the Department of Transportation, and shall be illuminated at night or so placed as to be illuminated by the headlights of approaching vehicles or by street lights.

COMMENTARY

This subsection does not have a UVC counterpart.
It is verbatim the same as subsection (4) of ORS 483.204.

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PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO

RIGHT OF WAY
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Section _____. (Right of way at merging lanes of arterial highway.) (1) A driver entering a freeway or other arterial highway where an acceleration or merging lane is provided for his use shall look out for and give right of way to vehicles on the freeway or other arterial highway.

(2) A driver entering a freeway or other arterial highway who fails to yield the right of way as provided in subsection (1) of this section commits a _____.

COMMENTARY

A. Summary

Subsection (1) provides that the driver entering a freeway or other arterial highway on an acceleration or merging lane must yield the right of way to vehicles on the highway.

Subsection (2) classifies the offense.

B. Derivation

This section is a restatement of subsection (1) of ORS 483.202.

C. Relationship to Existing Law

ORS 483.202 would be repealed and the provisions of subsection (1) contained in this section.
