

This informational catalogue is unique to our program and represents our business dating back from 1971 to present. We hope you find it of interest. ICSB has always been a program for the dog breeder and interested dog owners. Our exclusive products and services have been developed over the past 46 years in our laboratory to offer the best options for dog breeders around the world. We have provided our list of 54 ICSB semen freezing centers in 15 countries in the US, Canada, Mexico, South America, Europe, Japan, Trinidad-Tobago, and Taiwan. Our catalogue discusses some of the more commonly asked questions from dog breeders about canine semen collection, evaluation, freezing, storage and insemination. ICSB is proud to share the current totals from data we have been collecting over the past 36 months. Our staff has spent several hundred hours gathering the laboratory results for this report. In the last 3 years of ICSB operations at our Sandy, Oregon laboratory, 2,647 inseminations were performed. At the Gresham Animal Hospital (GAH), which performs our frozen semen surgical inseminations, 1,023 bitches were surgically inseminated, of which 89.2% conceived. Litter sizes produced at GAH showed 48.7% with greater than 2 puppies per litter. Litters as large as 14 puppies were produced over the past 3 years.

Other facilities were also providing us with their results, with 1279 semen shipments sent out from our laboratory. Of these, 76% of the bitches bred conceived, with litters of 2 or more puppies produced in 36.8% of the pregnancies.

Semen that Carrol had collected and froze in 1971 was thawed and inseminated in 2015 with a thaw recovery of 75%, which was only 5% less than that observed when it was first frozen. This insemination produced a pregnancy producing 6 healthy Beagle puppies, two of which live close by with past ICSB laboratory employees.

The ICSB pellet system of freezing semen has been used to store semen from over 512 species of mammals and birds.
