The House and Senate Committees on Education convened at 9:00 AM at the Oregon Youth Authority (“OYA”) MacLaren Youth Correctional Facility (“MacLaren”), 2630 North Pacific Highway, Woodburn, OR 97071. The purpose of the meeting was to tour the grounds of the facility with specific focus on the school programs operated therein by the Oregon Department of Education (“ODE”). The tour was led by OYA Director Fariborz Pakseresht, Lord High School Principal Michael Conn, and other members of OYA and ODE staff. Legislative staff from the Office of Committee Services and the Legislative Fiscal Office also attended the tour.

Committee members toured the grounds of the facility, including tours of residential areas and Lord High School campus, which is contained within MacLaren. In addition, members toured specialized programs on the MacLaren campus, including the “Project Pooch” service animal training program, cosmetology and barber training program, master gardener training program, metal- and wood-fabrication shops, and the auto mechanic training program.
