

Joint Interim Special Committee on Public Education Appropriation

Proposed rules adopted (date)

The Joint Interim Special Committee will operate in accordance with the Oregon Constitution, House and Senate Rules, custom, usage and precedents, Mason's Manual of Legislative Procedure, and applicable statutory provisions.

- 1. The Joint Interim Special Committee on Public Education Appropriation shall include a Chair from each chamber appointed by the appointing authority.
- 2. The Co-Chairs shall set agendas and cause notice of the time and place of committee meetings in accordance with House and Senate Rules. In the event of a conflict in the rules, the more generous notice provisions apply. All meetings shall be open to the public and comply with public meetings law and open meetings requirements of the Oregon Constitution.
- 3. Voting by members of the committee will be by roll call if requested by a member.
- 4. All meetings of the committee shall be recorded. The audio records shall be indexed and shall be placed with the Oregon Archivist in accordance with Oregon law.
- 5. Testimony is welcome at the invitation of the presiding Co-Chair or at the request of the majority of the members
- 6. A quorum shall consist of a majority of the committee members from the House of Representatives and a majority of committee members from the Senate. A quorum is necessary for any action.
- 7. In the absence of a quorum, the presiding Co-Chair may assign fewer members to receive public testimony.
- 8. These rules may be changed by an affirmative vote of a quorum of the members of the committee, but at least one day's notice of any proposed change shall be given in writing to each member of the committee.
