FOLLOWING POLICY RECOMMENDATION FOR INCLUSION IN OUR  
DECEMBER 2015 REPORT AND REQUEST THAT THE TASK FORCE  
SEEK TO HAVE THE RECOMMENDATION DRAFTED FOR  
LEGISLATION TO BE INTRODUCED IN THE FEBRUARY 2016  
LEGISLATIVE SESSION: ENACT AN AMENDMENT TO THE OREGON  
CONSTITUTION THAT WILL READ: BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE  
OF THE STATE OF OREGON, THERE IS ADDED AN ARTICLE II,  
SECTION 25 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF OREGON AS FOLLOWS: TO  
THE EXTENT ALLOWED BY THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION  
AND THE FIRST AMENDMENT THEREOF, THE OREGON  
CONSTITUTION ALLOWS LAWS: LIMITING ELECTORAL CAMPAIGN  
CONTRIBUTIONS, LIMITING ELECTORAL CAMPAIGN  
EXPENDITURES, AND REQUIRING DISCLOSURE TO THE PUBLIC  
AND IN ELECTORAL COMMUNICATIONS OF THE TRUE SOURCES  
OF THOSE CONTRIBUTIONS OR EXPENDITURES. SUCH LAWS MAY  
BE ADOPTED BY THE PEOPLE THROUGH THE INITIATIVE PROCESS  
OR BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. HOWEVER, ANY SUCH LAW  
ADOPTED BY THE LEGISLATURE MUST BE SUBJECT TO A  
REFERENDUM. EVERY SECTION AND APPLICATION OF THIS  
AMENDMENT SHALL BE EVALUATED SEPARATELY. IF ANY  
SECTION OR APPLICATION IS INCONSISTENT WITH THE UNITED  
STATES CONSTITUTION, THE INTENT OF THE ELECTORS OF  
OREGON IS THAT THE REMAINING SECTIONS AND APPLICATIONS  
SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT. ENACT A STATUTORY  
PROVISION THAT PROVIDES: SHOULD AN OREGON  
CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT RELATED TO POLITICAL  
CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS BE PASSED BY THE VOTERS IN  
OREGON'S NOVEMBER 2016 ELECTION, THEN THE ENFORCEMENT

AND APPLICABILITY OF ALL PROVISIONS CONTAINED IN THE 2006 BALLOT MEASURE 47 SHALL BE STAYED UNTIL THE DATE THAT MAJOR PARTY CANDIDATES MAY FILE FOR OREGON'S 2018 PRIMARY ELECTION.
