Marion County Jail and Marion County Circuit Court Annex**

The House and Senate Committees on Judiciary convened at 8:15 AM at the Marion County Jail and Marion County Circuit Court Annex, 4000 Aumsville HWY SE, Salem, OR. The purpose of the joint meeting was to tour the grounds and educate members about the practices and program of the Marion County Jail and the Marion County Circuit Court Annex. The tour provided information on all jail processes, from intake to jail staffing. The committees expressed interest in services offered to incarcerated persons, especially for those persons with a mental health diagnosis. The tour included visits to a housing unit, laundry work area and command center. The tour of the Marion County Jail concluded at approximately 9:20 AM. Several members then entered the Marion County Circuit Court Annex, where they had a Q & A with Honorable Rafael Caso. During the Q & A the committees learned about court processes, such as programs available to defendants with a mental health diagnosis.
