Marion County Jail and Marion County Circuit Court Annex

The House and Senate Committees on Judiciary convened at 8:15 AM at the Marion County Jail and Marion County Circuit Court Annex, 4000 Aumsville HWY SE, Salem, OR. The purpose of the joint meeting was to tour the grounds and educate members about the practices and program of the Marion County Jail and the Marion County Circuit Court Annex.
