The House and Senate Committees on Judiciary convened at 2:00 PM at the Coffee Creek Correctional Facility, 24499 SW Grahams Ferry Road, Wilsonville, OR. The purpose of the joint meeting was to tour the grounds and educate members about the practices and programs of the Coffee Creek Correctional Facility. The attendees split into two groups for the tour. The tour provided information on all prison processes, from intake to educational opportunities provided to inmates. The committees expressed interest in programs offered to incarcerated persons, especially work-based education programs, as well as capacity issues with Coffee Creek Correction Facility. The tour included visits to a housing unit, work-based education program facilities, cafeteria and grounds. Attendees viewed the work produced by inmates, such as chairs and bird baths, in the electrical, welding and painting shops. They were also able to meet some of the inmates participating in the welding program. The tour concluded at 4:30 PM.
