**FIELD TRIP SUMMARY:**

On Thursday, June 22, 2017, the House Veterans and Emergency Preparedness Committee attended a prearranged briefing/tour of the Anderson Readiness Center located at 3225 State Street, Salem, Oregon. The tour lasted from approximately 3:00 to 4:15. Primary briefers included Matt Marheine, Deputy Director of the Oregon Office of Emergency Management (OEM), Dave Stuckey, Deputy Director of the Oregon Military Department, and Colonel Stuart Matthew, Director of the Joint Staff.
