The report of the Credentials Committee does not appear. It seems, however, that sixteen senators were entitled to seats and fifteen of these did qualify and take part in the Session. The name of Mr. S. R. Scott, who was a senator from Josephine County, does not appear in any of the proceedings. It is probable he did not attend the Session. In one place in the Journal, Mr. S. R. Scott is listed as being absent.
