His name carried on roll call through the Regular Session and the 1920 Special Session. George D Chenoweth was sent to represent Curry County with the request that he be allowed to "look after" the interests of the county. House Resolution 28 gave him courtesies of the floor but "without the privileges of voting or participating in the proceedings of the House."
