# Foster Aerospace Protected Trademark

## 1. USE OF TRADEMARK

Foster Aerospace LLC (The Company) provides both products and services to its customers. Thus it does not differentiate between the words trademark and service mark and the more common term *trademark* is used inclusively. The Company's trademark is used to identify all of its products and services as well as real and intellectual property of which The Company owns.

## 2. ESTABLISHED AND PROTECTED TRADEMARK

The Company's trademark consists of a combination of company name, words (tag-line), symbol (logo), and a website favorites icon (aka favicon). The trademark is established by use, protected as Company property by trademark law, and registered with the Oregon Secretary of State – Corporation Division. The following are the components of The Company's trademark:

- TAG LINE (SLOGAN):

***“Engineering for earth, air, and space ”***

- LOGO:



- FAVICON (ICON):




### 3. APPEARANCE OF TRADEMARK

The individual components of The Company's trademark may appear in use either singularly or in groups in any variety of arrangements as may be appropriate. For example, The Company's name, logo and slogan trademark elements all appear arranged together on business cards as seen here:



And, on letterhead as see here:



Within written text (for example, the body of documents), The Company name usually appears *without* the LLC designator or sometimes *with* the LLC designator in full-sized black colored text (as seen below and in the copyright notice herein the footer of this document) rather than the half-sized gray colored text (as seen above).

### 4. DETAIL INFORMATION

- **DESIGNER:** All components of The Company trademark—including all artwork—are proprietary, original, and custom-designed by Jon A. Foster.
- **FONT:** The Company name and tag-line (slogan) use a non-standard public domain font called *Final Frontier*. The name and tag-line are both used with an applied text style of bold and italic.

**Important Note:** The special font is usually embedded in all Company documents so as to appear properly to any user. Otherwise, the font may default to a more common font such as Times New Roman unless the font is otherwise *first* installed on the user's computer prior to opening a Company document. Some applications (e.g. a website html text editor) may not allow use of a special font, in which case a more common font must be and will be used in its place.

- **COLORS:** The components of the Company's trademark use four specific colors. Here are their RGB color codes:

Green            R: 0  
                    G: 150  
                    B: 0

Blue             R: 0  
                    G: 0  
                    B: 255

Black            R: 0  
                    G: 0  
                    B: 0

Gray             R: 100  
                    G: 100  
                    B: 100

The colors noted above are those used by default for documents and other media displayed by computer LCD monitors. The colors *may* be adjusted for print (e.g. CMYK coded) materials as necessary so that the colors are represented correctly. The colors *may* also be adjusted for use with website HTML editor color palettes (e.g. those typically requiring Hexadecimal color codes).

- **LOGO:** The custom designed logo consists of three aerospace craft representative of seagulls (i.e. symbolic artwork). One on earth (green), one in the air (blue), and one in space (black) thus echoing The Company's "...*earth, air, and space*" tag-line (slogan).
- **FILE TYPES:** The name and slogan are generally displayed as text objects within DOC, HTML, and most other types of files. The text used is a true-type TTF file. The original logo is a JPG image file. The favorites icon (favicon) is an ICO file used for the website and desktop icon applications; it also exists as a BMP image file for use as an end of article symbol in publications.
- **TRADEMARK SYMBOL:** The trademark symbol <sup>TM</sup> may or may not be placed next to The Company trademark (or any of its components). The symbol is optional and not required by law to establish and protect the property [identity] of The Company but only indicates that a trademark is registered (but not with the federal government). The symbol ® would only be used in the case when/if the trademark is registered with the federal government: i.e. United States Patent and Trademark Office.
