**LC 146** - Exempts amateur athletes who are at least age 16, but no older than age 21, and play for a junior ice hockey team from certain employment regulations. These regulations include workers' compensation, wage rate, payment, collection and claim enforcement, employment conditions, employment of minors, and unemployment insurance. Defines junior ice hockey team.

**LC 205** - Extends existing attorney-client privilege to communications between persons seeking to obtain legal services and lawyer referral services. Defines lawyer referral service.

**LC 206** - Relating to courts. Directs the Oregon Association for Court Administration, rather than the League of Oregon Cities and the Association of Oregon Counties, to provide the Legislative Fiscal Officer with information relating to the operation of local courts. Makes affidavits submitted to the court in support of a settlement of a personal injury claim involving a minor, decedent or incapacitated person confidential, unless the court finds good cause to order otherwise.
