PROCLAMATION

To mark this memorable day in history, the triumph of the American forces and their allies over the enemy in Europe, and the establishment of the sweeping victory of democracy, I, Earl Snell, Governor of Oregon, do hereby declare this day, Tuesday, May 8, 1945, to be one during which there should be observed a period for prayerful thanksgiving and determined rededication to goals yet before us.

In observance of today's great achievement, Oregon and its citizens must not and will not forget that there is yet another enemy to conquer. We must go forward with renewed zeal and determination toward that day when peace will be established on all our fighting fronts and in all the world.

We will pray ardently for divine guidance at the San Francisco conference, that there may be brought forth a great memorial toward the creation of a just and lasting peace for all mankind.
