Entered Military Service from Oregon.

French Legion d'Honneur (chevalier), by Presidential Decree of May 5, 1919, and French Croix de Guerre with palm, under Order No. 16.034 "D", dated April 13, 1919, General Headquarters, French Armies of the East, with the following citation: "An officer of admirable courage and zeal. Becoming separated from his company while it was crossing the Meuse on November 5, 1918, the bridge having been destroyed by the artillery he plunged into the water ordering his men to follow. By his energy he forced the enemy to fall back one kilometer, took some machine gun nests and captured 100 prisoners, a number greater than the strength of his detachment."

Italian Croce di Guerra, awarded by the Chief of Staff, Italian Army, December 9, 1921. (No specific citation of record.)  
Montenegrin Ordre du Prince Danilo I (officier. "For meritorious services rendered the Allied cause.")
