## INTRODUCTION

Historically, Oregon has conducted direct nominating primary elections. At these elections, major political party candidates were nominated for the general election by voters from their respective major political parties. Voters who were registered as not affiliated with any political party (NAV) or as members of minor political parties were only allowed to cast ballots for nonpartisan offices and measures. In the 1987 Legislature, a bill was adopted which allowed major political parties to open their nominating primary elections to the nonaffiliated voter (ORS 254.365).

A nonaffiliated voter is defined as an individual who has chosen not to be a member of any political party and has indicated this on his/her voter registration card. Some counties refer to NAVs as "Independents" or "IND".

In 1990 and 1992, the Republican party chose to open its primary election to nonaffiliated voters. The Democratic party did not choose to do this. Voters who were registered as NAVs were permitted to vote either the nonpartisan ballot they had voted in the past or the Republican ballot (except the section of the ballot containing the office of precinct committeeperson).

The statistics on the following pages reflect the NAVs who voted Republican. Any NAVs who chose to vote the nonpartisan ballot are included with "others" in the voting statistics.
