## Position Review - Department of Human Resources -- Employment Division

Senator Fadeley explained that at the time Subcommittee No. 3 heard the budget of the Employment Division, all of the reclassification recommendations from the Personnel Division were not known, and it was agreed these could be considered at a later date. On March 31, 1975, the Personnel Division recommended reclassification of 13 positions.

Senator Fadeley moved that the Joint Ways and Means Committee, acting under authority of ORS 291.371, approve the reclassification of 13 positions in the Employment Division of the Department of Human Resources.

Senator McCoy asked whether only federal funds are involved. Senator Fadeley replied it is, although the additional cost of approximately \$678 per month would be recovered through abolishment or downward reclassification of positions.

Senator Fadeley's motion carried unanimously.

## Budget bills considered by Subcommittee and now before Full Committee:

House Bill 5064--Relating to certain financial administration of the state; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.

Representative Johnson noted that the Emergency Fund is available for distribution to state agencies for emergencies and unforeseen contingencies. Subcommittee No. 1 restored the \$4 million the Governor deleted from the request, making the appropriation \$12 million, which is \$700,000 less than the amount available during the current biennium.

Representative Johnson moved that House Bill 5064 be amended by deleting "\$8,000,000" and inserting "\$12,000,000" in line 7 of the printed bill, and deleting "on its passage" and inserting "July 1, 1975" in line 11, and that it be reported out "Do pass as amended."

Senator Ripper moved to amend Representative Johnson's motion by substituting "\$15,000,000" for \$12,000,000".

Senator Ripper was concerned that there would be additional general purpose needs which would make the additional amount necessary. In response to Senator Roberts' question, Representative Akeson thought this a reasonable amount to set aside in the Emergency Fund for contingencies, which could be salaries, inflationary factors or other reasons.

Senator Fadeley asked whether these amounts included, for instance, the \$1 million for LCDC appropriated to the Emergency Fund. Representative Akeson replied that amounts earmarked for specific purposes are not included and would not be available for general emergencies.

Senator Ripper's motion to amend carried unanimously.

Representative Johnson's motion, as amended, carried unanimously on roll call vote.

# SUMMARY OF SUBCOMMITTEE ACTION:

The Subcommittee recommended an Emergency Fund totaling \$12,000,000. This was increased to \$15 million by the Full Committee to enable the Emergency Board to allocate moneys to those state agencies that operate with General Fund appropriations and cannot absorb the salary underfunding.

## EMERGENCY FUND

## House Bill 5064

This is the budget bill for the Emergency Fund which, as you know, is the Fund available for distribution to state agencies for emergencies and unforeseen contingencies. The Committee restored the \$4,000,000 the Governor deleted from the request, making the appropriation \$12,000,000. This amount is \$700,000 less than the Fund that was available to the Emergency Board during the 1973-75 interim.

An additional \$3,000,000 was added to the Fund by Full Committee action.

This was done to insure that adequate moneys would be available for allocation to those state agencies that cannot absorb the salary underfunding.
