Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1975, out of the General Fund, the sum of \$15 million as an emergency fund allocation as provided in ORS 291.322 to 291.328.

SECTION 2. This Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Act takes effect July 1, 1975.




