### The Vote for Vice President and Presidential Electors.

Oregon Election Law provides that the names of candidates for President and Vice President of the United States shall be printed together, under their political party designations. To vote for electors of President and Vice President, the voter marks a cross (X) inside a voting square between the number and the group containing the names of his choice for President and Vice President. Each ballot so marked and voted shall be counted as one vote for the group of Presidential Electors supporting the candidates for President and Vice President designated by the voter as his choice. The vote for Vice President and Presidential Electors has not been included in that the vote for these offices is the same as that shown for President.

For clarity and for general information we here state that Spiro T. Agnew was elected Vice President and that the following listed individuals were elected Republican Presidential Electors.
