Provide an explanation of any difference between the hand count and the tally of votes produced by the vote tally system, as determined by the counting board.
- If no exceptions or differences are identified by the counting board, the results for all precincts and batches may be summarized on a single form.
- Only one certification is required to be signed and returned with results.


