HB 2096 A

(For discussion purposes only) Increases maximum agriculture workforce housing tax credits issued by Housing and Community Services Department to \$24 million per biennium.

HB 2446

(For discussion purposes only) Extends sunset of property tax exemption for property of nonprofit corporation offered, occupied or used as low-income housing.

HB 3364

(For discussion purposes only) Creates credit against income taxes for purchasing publicly supported housing to retain as affordable housing.

HB 2584 A

(For discussion purposes only) Increases total amount of tax credits for affordable housing lenders allowed for all taxpayers per fiscal year.
