## What is Liberty House?

Liberty House is the Children's Advocacy Center serving Marion and Polk counties – the only place providing special assessment services in a safe, comfortable, child-friendly environment.

Since 1999, Liberty House has provided child-focused, high quality assessment services to children when adults are concerned they may have been hurt by sexual abuse, physical abuse, or neglect. With compassion and expertise, medical providers conduct comprehensive medical examinations for the children coming to Liberty House. Specially trained child interviewers also help children talk about what has happened to them in a neutral and sensitive manner to ensure the objectivity of the assessment and the wellbeing of the child.

Complementing the assessment are family support services for caregivers, including information and resources for keeping children safe and healthy.
