To All to Whom these Presents May Come, Greeting:

Know Ye, That whereas, MARGARET FORTINER, MARY TUTHILL, ELEANOR L. EASTMAN and HAZEL E. CARLSON, having presented Articles of Incorporation of a Corporation organized and formed for educational purposed, under and pursuant to the Laws of the State of Oregon, and paid the organization fee provided by "An Act to provide for the licensing of Domestic Corporations and Foreign Corporations, Joint Stock Companies and Associations, etc.," approved February 16, 1903;

Now, Therefore, I, Ben W. Olcott, ["F.W. Benson" crossed out] Secretary of State of the State of Oregon, Do Hereby Certify, that said Articles of Incorporation have been filed and recorded in the office of the Secretary of State; that the name assumed by said corporation is THE WOMEN'S POLITICAL SCIENCE CLUB the duration perpetual; the enterprise, business, pursuit or occupation of this corporation is to further the development of the mental capacity of its members and others, and for the study of political science. In the furtherance of this object this corporation is to establish, equip and maintain a club house or rooms with the usual conveniences for such an organization; and for that purpose to rent, lease, possess and hold real and personal property such as may be necessary to carry out the objects of this corporation.
