Graham of the Womans Christian Temperance Union of the town of Corvallis County of Benton and State of Oregon duly elected such officers by the usages and customs of said Society by said Society for the purpose

of incorporating said society under and in accordance with the Incorporation laws of the State of Oregon and for the purpose of carrying out the objects of said Society, do hereby make and subscribe in triplicate the following articles of incorporation

#### Article 1st

The name of this incorporation shall be the Womans Christian Temperance Union of Corvallis

### Article 2nd

This incorporation is formed for the purpose of and its objects are the development of the Christian moral temperance Social mental and physical capacities of its members and for Christian Social temperance and benevolent purposes and to purchase receive and posses Real and personal property for the purposes of said Corporation and to do and perform every-thing requisite and necessary to carryout the objects and pursue the business aforesaid.

#### Article 3

The value of all money and property now possessed by said society is about one thousand – dollars and the sources of the income of the said society are by assessments upon its members and voluntary contributions, gifts and bequests

#### Article 4

The titles of the officers making these articles of incorporation are President, Vice President, Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, Treasurer, Asst Secretary and Superintendents of Departments The mode and manner of electing said officers is by members of said society by ballot

The said Woman's Christian Temperance Union of Corvallis Oregon hereby incorporated is located at the town of Corvallis in Benton County, State of Oregon. The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual In witness whereof we have here =unto subscribed our names this 7 Day of May A D 1884
