This incorporation is formed for the purpose of and its objects are the development of the Christian moral temperance Social mental and physical capacities of its members and for Christian Social temperance and benevolent purposes and to purchase receive and posses Real and personal property for the purposes of said Corporation and to do and perform every-thing requisite and necessary to carryout the objects and pursue the business aforesaid.

Article 3

The value of all money and property now possessed by said society is about one thousand – dollars and the sources of the income of the said society are by assessments upon its members and voluntary contributions, gifts and bequests
